## About ONOS

Pursuant to the Hon'ble Prime Minister's call of "Jai Anusandhan" in his address from the Red Fort on the occasion of the 76th Independence Day (15 August 2022), the Government of India has launched the Prime Minister's One Nation One Subscription (PM-ONOS) initiative to strengthen the national research and innovation ecosystem. PM-ONOS seeks to provide seamless, nationwide access to high-quality national and international scholarly journals across all disciplines of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) as well as Social Sciences and Humanities (SSH). Through the negotiation of national-level licenses with leading global publishers and the consolidation of existing institutional and consortia-based subscriptions, the initiative ensures equitable, inclusive, and cost-effective access to scholarly literature for universities, colleges, research organisations, and the wider academic community across India. Approved as a Central Sector Scheme by the Union Cabinet and implemented by the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, PM-ONOS represents a transformative step towards democratising access to knowledge, fostering research excellence, and advancing evidence-based education and innovation in the country.

## Programme Details

The one-day outreach programme will be held on February 26, 2026 at the INFLIBNET Centre, Infocity, Gandhinagar, Gujarat.

## Target Participants

- ❖ The programme is intended for Institutions with IP-based access. Nodal Officers or Library Professionals responsible for the implementation of ONOS at their respective institutions are eligible to participate.
- ❖ Participation is restricted to one participant per institution. Only Universities, Higher Education Institutions, and R&D Institutions with registered IP-based access are eligible to participate.
- ❖ Selection of participants shall be made on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to a maximum limit of 100 participants.

## Registration Fee

- ❖ No registration fee shall be levied for attending the programme.
- ❖ Interested participants are required to register online at <https://www.onos.gov.in/outreach> on or before January 31, 2026.
- ❖ During the online registration process, each applicant must upload a nomination letter duly signed by the Head of the Department/Institution.

## Accommodation

- ❖ No accommodation charges will be levied.
- ❖ The INFLIBNET Centre shall provide twin-sharing accommodation for one selected participant from each registered institution, subject to a maximum limit of 100 participants.
